1. Purchase Terms

The Buyer agrees to purchase the above-described puppy for \$_____. A deposit of \$_____ has been paid, with the remaining balance due upon transfer of the puppy.

The deposit is non-refundable and will hold the puppy until the agreed pick-up/delivery date. If the Buyer chooses not to proceed with the purchase, the deposit is forfeited.

2. Two-Year Limited Health Guarantee

The Breeder guarantees the puppy is in good health at the time of sale and free from any life-threatening congenital or hereditary disorders that would significantly impact quality of life or longevity. This guarantee is valid for two (2) years from the date of birth, provided the following conditions are met:

Buyer Responsibilities:

1. Initial Vet Visit – Puppy must be examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours (3 days) of receipt. Proof of exam must be available upon request.

2. Pet Insurance – Buyer must activate and maintain the 30-day free pet insurance plan (Trupanion or equivalent, if applicable) at the time of pick-up/delivery.
3. Proper Care – Buyer agrees to provide appropriate care, nutrition, shelter, vaccinations, parasite prevention, and regular veterinary care.

3. Exclusions from Guarantee

This guarantee does NOT cover:

- Non-life-threatening conditions (e.g., minor hernias, undescended testicles, cosmetic issues)
- Breed-common genetic traits unless specifically stated otherwise
- Illness or injury caused by neglect, trauma, overexertion, or accidents
- Internal or external parasites (common and easily treatable)
- Conditions arising from poor nutrition, vaccine reactions, or failure to follow veterinary recommendations

4. Claim Procedure

If a covered life-threatening condition is diagnosed within the two-year period:

1. Buyer must notify the Breeder within 48 hours of diagnosis.
2. Diagnosis must be confirmed in writing by two licensed veterinarians.
3. Once verified, the Breeder will offer one of the following options (at Breeder's discretion):
 - Replace the puppy with one of equal value from a future litter, OR
 - Refund up to 50% of the purchase price.

The puppy may NOT be euthanized without written approval from the Breeder, except in emergencies where a licensed veterinarian deems it necessary.

5. Return Policy

If the Buyer becomes unable to keep the puppy for any reason:

- The Breeder must be contacted first.
- The puppy may not be surrendered to a shelter or rescue.
- The Breeder reserves right of first refusal and will assist with rehoming if needed.

If the puppy is returned to the Breeder and is successfully rehomed to a new family for a fee, the original Buyer may be eligible for reimbursement of the sale amount minus any reasonable expenses incurred by the Breeder (such as boarding, veterinary care, grooming, transportation, or advertising costs). Proof of these expenses will be provided upon request.

6. Entire Agreement

This contract represents the entire agreement between Breeder and Buyer. No other guarantees or warranties are implied or expressed unless added in writing and signed by both parties.
